THE RENOIRS VILLAGE AT ESSOYES IN CHAMPAGNE

Welcomed at the Renoir Cultural Centre, find how the painter was passionate about the small birthplace of his wife Aline and where he spent almost thirty summers, with a screening of a film and a permanent exhibition on the Renoir family.



In the heart of the village, you will follow in the footsteps of Renoir to discover the village. It will bring to light a more intimate Renoir in the privacy of the House and his creativity in the Studio of Renoir, both labeled Maison des Illustres.

To conclude this tour, a visit to the family graves at the cemetery is essential. Indeed, Pierre-Auguste Renoir loved this village so much that the painter, his wife Aline, and their three sons, Pierre the actor, Jean the filmmaker and Claude aka "Coco" the ceramist, are all buried there.
